Activity/Use	Fee Amount	Mandatory*/Voluntary	Purpose
Chromebook Fee (All)	\$25/student (max \$50/family) for first time loss or damage and up to \$250 for repeat occurrences.	Mandatory	Funds repairs for technology; ensures full cost does not get passed on to family
Student Uniform Fee (All)	\$8-\$18, depending on school	Mandatory	Purchase of 1 school uniform
Athletic (MS)	\$25/student - per sport(max \$50/year)	Voluntary, based on participation	Covers a percentage of the operating budget for the sport.
Athletic (HS)	\$40/student - per sport (max \$80/year)	Voluntary, based on participation	Covers a percentage of the operating budget for the sport.
Textbooks (non expendable)	Actual cost, may vary	To ensure that textbooks/library books are returned to the school in useable condition	Only charged if damaged
Advanced Placement/Expendable text /Concurrent Enrollment (including workbooks)	Actual cost, may vary	Mandatory if enrolled in the class	Item is not reusable
Advanced Learning Course Fee/Continuing Education Continuation Programs***	No cost, unless student does not complete or pass (Per credit/hr tuition) ¹		Tuition cost

¹ If the student receives a grade of a “D”, “F”, or an “Incomplete” or withdraws from a course after the college drop deadline, the student and the student’s parent or guardian may be required to pay STRIVE Prep for the tuition of the course. Tuition will be charged at the approved state community college rate as paid by STRIVE Prep to the IHE.

Miscellaneous registration or activity fees	Varies (Speech and Debate dues)	Voluntary, dependent on student participation	Actual cost of registration/activity and/or cost to support programming (drama, debate team, etc)

*All mandatory fees shall be waived for students that are verified as homeless, unaccompanied, and/or foster children. Waivers for mandatory fees shall also be granted, when requested by parents, for students eligible for free or reduced-price lunch under the National Income Poverty Guidelines.

Principals have discretion to waive voluntary fees due to economic hardship when requested.

Waivers of certain fees may be granted for students with individual education plans (IEP) when the service or program is written in as a related service on their IEP.
